The Holy Ghost acts as a cleansing agent to purify them and sanctify us from all sin...thus it is often spoken of as “fire”.






As disciples of Christ, we keep our "savor" by avoiding spiritual contamination from the world. This allows us to fulfill our preserving and purifying work as the salt of the earth
